Meeting called to order. Start time: 12pm

President (Sarah):

- Great job on coffee and sip Lori!
- Looking forward to paint and sip, it seems we have a lot of RSVP's!

Treasurer (Tara):

- SumUp: € 239.87

No new funding request. Website is slightly funky still will work this month to be resolved.

- Met with the bank and they are looking into a waiver for us for the 90 day cut off with our bank accounts due to the lapse of private org status. Private Org request is with legal. Community Bank is concerned they are not going to be able to meet the requirements of NATO and we might need another bank account due to their requirements.... More to come on that!
- Pop up Bingo ticket sales 5 Feb @ the Rotodome. 21 May for MWA Bunco night?
- Member tickets are for the member only - Lori checks at the door of events to make sure people are not buying incorrect tickets.
- Discussed current bank account : NATO sounds like they would like access to our bank account for audits, and would like 2-step varification, but Community Bank does not currently have a system for that. No current written regulations are available, but people are telling Tara above rules. If USD account is terminated, money orders will be required. Tara will continue to work with Okeef.
- 80's theme for May 21 MWR Bunco night.
- For Bingo night, we need to provide gift baskets (9). No raffle tickets can be sold. Will need to find a Bingo caller - can source outside of ASGK
- Reviewed 4th of July planning meeting, Brunsumm is looking for private orgs to make up for 1K deficit in spending. Will not provide funds, but will consider having a booth or other involvement.
