# **Funding Request:**

Scouting of America: asking for \$500 Offset cost of membership fees/ September 1-8, 2025/JFC Scout Hut; Due to the nature of our community and the lack of fundraising opportunities for the Scouts, our membership fees are much higher than Scouting troops in the States. The money from ASGK would be used to offset our local membership fees. Our membership fees cover the cost of our annual rechartering fee, merit badges and awards, ranks and pins, troop supplies (camping equipment, rental fees, items needed for merit badges such as ropes, gardening equipment, etc.,) Scoutbooks for each scout, and uniform pieces (neckerchiefs, council and number patches, shoulder loops, and merit badge sashes.) Most scouts earn on average 10 merit badges a year, which by itself is equal to \$50 per scout. Our Troop has 18 current members and we are hoping to add more with new families that PCSed over the summer. The cost of merit badges alone is over \$900 a year, which doesn't take into account our overachieving scouts that earn more than 10 merit badges a year, or the cost of multiple ranks earned throughout the scouting year or any of the other costs included in the above description of what our membership fee covers for our scouts.; Funds received from other orgs: American Legion Post 300-\$300

We gave troop 500; Sarah motions to approve, Amina seconds, passes

**Local Command Esports League:** € 50-75; This will be a video game tournament similar to the Mario Kart 8 tournament ASGK supported. The idea is to use all cash as a prize pool for participants of the tournament. This is open to all who are allowed access to bldg 109 on GK

Sarah motion to approve 75, Jen second, passed

Consider paper bags and stamps/stickers to present gift cards with branding
